



ST. MARY'S ELEMENTARY SCHOOL
SCHOOL CRITERIA FOR ACCEPTANCE OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

1. The student should have basics of English, both spoken and written. We do have an E.L.L. program at St. Mary's School. After acceptance into St. Mary's, a student may be required to attend E.L.L. classes during or after school hours at no charge. Basic school supplies are provided at no charge.
2. To apply for admission to St. Mary's School:
 - Please complete the Pre-Registration Form; **note submitting this form does not indicate acceptance at St. Mary's**
 - Please attach your most recent transcript (in English) of academic marks *if possible*
 - Please attach a copy of your current Passport or Student Visa
 - If residing in Canada, please attach a copy of your guardian's Canadian Citizen ship or Landed Immigrant document.
3. An appointment on zoom will be set up with the Principal, the student applying, parent or the guardian.
4. Upon acceptance, the tuition is due in advance and is non-refundable.

\$500.00 Activity Fee (\$50.00 per month per student) all standard fieldtrips & activities

* For Grade 7 students only (optional field trip with additional fees: North Vancouver Outdoor School (3 days and 2 nights in May)

Upon receipt of tuition payment, a Letter of Acceptance will be issued. The tuition is not refundable. Upon acceptance, a school uniform will need to be purchased.

5. For a student applying outside the country, this letter will be sent to the applicant and they should apply for a Student Visa at their nearest Canadian Immigration office. This process can take 6-8 weeks. A copy of the Student Visa must be sent to St. Mary's School as soon as it is received.
6. We have no dormitory facilities at St. Mary's and the student should reside with an English speaking family. Contact/Homestay information must be given to the school. If applicable, per Canadian regulations, the student must follow any strict quarantine procedures upon arrival.
7. Standards regarding absenteeism and participation in extra-curricular activities should be agreed to at the time of application.
